DESCRIPTION

Ca. 3 – 5 m² pro liter solution.

PRACTICAL CONSUMPTION

Consumption is heavily dependent on the surface roughness and fouling.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

Clean the surface, the wet the surfaces to be treated, and allow to soak in for minimally 16 hours

After the soak-in period, spray off the surface with the help of a brush or sanding pad. For preventative action, treat the surface again and allow to dry.

Apply the product with a low-pressure spray.

Use Algae Killer Concentrate diluted to a ratio between 1:25 to 1:100 dependent on the degree of fouling of the surface.

Capture contaminated water and prevent it reaching the ground, surface water, or the sewers.

APPLICATION CONDITIONS

Minimum ambient temperature : 10 °C. Minimum surface temperature : 10 °C. Maximum ambient temperature : 30 °C.

CLEANING OF EQUIPMENT / SPILLS

Rinse with water immediately after use.

REMARKS

Use Algae Killer Concentrate diluted between 1:25 to 1:100 dependent on the degree of fouling of the surface.

Capture contaminated water and prevent it reaching the ground, surface water, or the sewers.
