DESCRIPTION

For the easy removal of old and hard lime and cement deposits from acid-proof surfaces. Also suitable for the removal of cement scum.

RECOMMENDED USE

Chalk-Cement-Ex Concentrate is suitable for removing lime and cement residues from a variety of acid-resistant surfaces. It is also suitable for use as an 'etching agent' for smooth cement-based floors, and so on, and as a descaler for pipes, boilers, etc.

PRACTICAL CONSUMPTION

Maximum dilution: 1:10. Consumption is heavily dependent on the level of dirt and the desired result.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

Dilute Chalk-Cement-Ex Concentrate with water to maximally 1:10. In case of vertical surfaces, work from the bottom to the top to avoid runs and streaks. Apply the product using a sponge or hand spray gun and allow to soak in for 5 to 10 minutes. If necessary, use a car-washing brush or white pad as an aid. If the red colour changes into a yellowish white colour before the desired end result is achieved, Chalk-Cementex-Ex must be reapplied. After use, rinse thoroughly with water until a neutral surface is obtained. Chalk-Cement-Ex Concentrate applications, such as in refill spray bottle, dilute in the mixture ration of 150 ml Chalk-Cement-Ex Concentrate to 350 ml clean water. First, try out a test surface
